FUSD English Learner Reclassification Criteria

To be implemented throughout the school year as students reach the criteria.

1) Assessment of English language proficiency, using an objective assessment instrument, including but not limited to, the state test of English language proficiency:

Current English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC)

- Overall Well Developed Performance Level (Level 4)
- 2) Teacher Evaluation, including, but not limited to, a review of the student's curriculum mastery
- 3) Parent Opinion and Consultation
- 4) Comparison of student performance in basic skills against an empirically established range of performance in basic skills based on the performance of English proficient students of the same age:
 - Students may meet the performance in basic skills by meeting one of the following criteria:
